**I**NTELLIGENCE has been received by Government of the death of CHACA, who was murdered by his Subjects on the 23d September, in an insurrection, occasioned by his excessive and increasing cruelties, and headed by several of his brothers. Lieut. FAREWELL arrived on the 16th instant, at Port Elizabeth, in the Schooner *Elizabeth and Susan*, commanded by Mr. ISAACS. Messrs. KING and HUTTON are dead; and it appears, that FYNN and OGLE, are the only British Subjects still remaining at Port Natal.

As CHACA's Successor was not elected at the time Mr. FAREWELL left Port Natal, and the Zoolahs were still in a very unsettled state, the Mission which was about to proceed under Capt. AITCHISON, has been countermanded.

**B**ERIGTEN zyn ontvangen aangaande den dood van Chaka, die op den 23 September door zyne onderdanen is vermoord geworden in eenen opstand (onder aanvoering van eenige zynere Broederen) door deszelfs buitensporige en toenemende wreedheden veroorzaakt.—Luitenant Farewell is op den 16 dezer te Port Elizabeth aangekomen in de Schooner *Elizabeth and Susan*, gecommandeerd door den Hr. Isaacs.—De Heeren King en Hutton zyn dood; en het blykt dat Fynn en Ogle de eenigste Britsche onderdanen zyn welke zich thans te Port Natal bevinden.—Daar de opvolger van Chaka nog niet benoemd was toen Luit. Farewell Port Natal verliet, en de Zoolahs als nog in eenen verwarden staat waren, is de Missie welke onder geleide van Kapitein Aitchison stond afgevaardigd te worden, gestaakt.
