

BELIEVED TO BE LOST.

**Steamer and Crew of Fourteen May
Have Sunk in Lake Michigan.**

Chicago, Ill., Oct. 27.—The steamer I. E. Doty with her crew of fourteen men is believed by marine men to have been lost in the great storm in mid lake off Kenosha. The names of the crew, so far as known: Captain, Christopher Smith, Port Huron; chief engineer, Thomas Abernathie, Port Huron; first mate, Harry Thorpe, Detroit; steward, Doss West, Bay City.

The remainder of the crew are not known to the owners in Cleveland.
