

STEAMER DOTY LOST.

Supposed to Have Gone Down With Crew
In Lake Michigan.

CHICAGO, Oct. 27.—The steamer L. R. Doty, with her crew of 15 men, is believed by marine men to have been lost in the great storm in mid-lake off Kenosha. The names of the crew so far as known are: Captain Christopher Smith, Port Huron; Chief Engineer Thomas Abernethy, Port Huron; First Mate Harry Thorpe, Detroit, and Steward Doss, West Bay City.

The probable fate of the Doty was learned by the tug Prodigy, which was sent out today to search for the Doty. About 25 miles off Kenosha the Prodigy came on a large amount of wreckage, which is said by the owners to correspond with the Doty.

The Doty was from Chicago and was laden with corn.
